SINCE INCEPTION

McKemie Place is the only emergency shelter for unaccompanied adult women in our region. In 2007, an unaccompanied homeless woman literally froze to her death on the streets of Mobile. The Mayor of Mobile formed a Homeless Coalition Task Force after Hurricane Katrina demolished the only existing women's shelter in the city. The Task Force members decided they could not wait for a shelter to be built and that they had to find somewhere for homeless women to be safe from the elements. McKemie Place was established and an agreement was put in place to utilize the facilities of the United Methodist Inner City Mission as an overnight emergency shelter. On average, McKemie serves 250 unaccompanied homeless adult, ambulatory women per year. Many of our guests are victims of violence, who found the courage to leave their abusers only to face the struggles of poverty. Lack of job skills and affordable housing, mental health issues and addiction are just a few of the brutal realities that these women face all alone. But when they come to McKemie Place, they get the opportunity to start a new chapter in their lives. Here, they're welcomed into a safe and caring community, where they have the emotional support and resources to heal and become self-reliant. In 2020, we expanded our hours of service to around the clock care and relocated our operation into a place of our own. McKemie Place currently provides a place for up to 50 homeless women to temporarily live while working to become self reliant.




In our program, clients meet with a case manager who assists them with creating attainable goals and meeting achievements that enable them to regain their independence and restore their self confidence. Women are connected with local resources to help them with furthering their education, encouraging them in their faith, obtaining employment, and finding a more permanent living arrangement. Our new facility allows McKemie Place to provide a 24/7 shelter for women in distress.

Annual Goals and Objectives

5-8% decrease in the number of guests that exit to a temporary destination

Of the 259 guests served in 2022, only 5% exited to a temporary destination; a decrease of 13% from 2021 Provide over 25,000 meals for our guests

Through the assistance of numerous dedicated volunteers, McKemie Place provided 32,112 meals in 2022 3-5% increase in the number of guests that exit to a positive destination

95% of our guests in 2022 left McKemie Place to go to a positive destination; up 16% from 2021

In 2022, McKemie Place expanded our current social enterprise, Chasing Dreams, to include a line of aprons made from men's button down oxford shirts and embellished with hand embroidered elements. Each apron is one of a kind and we can custom make an apron for consumers. Our aprons are available to the public for purchase at Do Goods Mercantile in downtown Mobile and retail for \$36.

Social enterprises produce a triple bottom line. They are beneficial for our community because they offer consumers quality handmade products created from repurposed items. Our social enterprise benefits McKemie Place by providing a source of sustainable income to help us accomplish our mission and it benefits the women who participate in in not only by






